The Spring 2024 CAPS Training may be a great opportunity for you!



CAPS Training/Position Requirements:

- **Lived Experience:** Individuals who are 18 years of age or older with an autism diagnosis. Please note that we have also accepted research evaluation reports.
- **Education/Employment History:**
 - ▶ A high school diploma or GED from an accredited institution
 - ▶ Within the past three years:
 - Maintained at least 12 months of successful full or part-time paid or voluntary work experience
 - or*
 - Obtained at least 24 credit hours of post-secondary education
- **Two professional references are required.** References can be past employers, educators, or other individuals who can speak to your skills and fit for this training program.



Application:

Rolling Admission until spots are filled.

Training Date and Time:

April 15th, 2024 – May 3rd, 2024. The training occurs over the course of 2-3 weeks (with one week devoted to job shadowing). The training will not take place every day. Participants should be prepared to be available **9 am – 5 pm**. Kindly be advised that the timeline is subject to change. We appreciate your understanding and will keep you updated on any adjustments.
